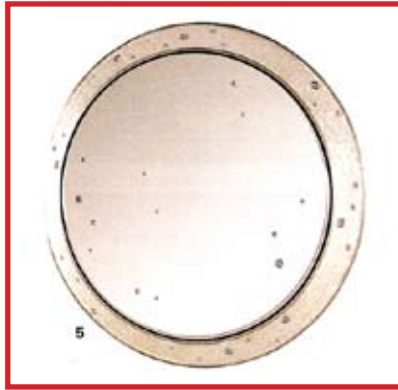

1 Marais by Doug and Gene Meyer for Niba Rug Collection. \$142 per square foot, features a silk pattern on a wool background. Handwoven in Nepal, the rug, shown in khaki green on slate gray, is available in custom colors and sizes.

2 The Woodland Veneer chair from Palecek. \$2,446, was inspired by Swedish midcentury designs. Made of plantation-grown wood, the piece is upholstered in eco-friendly fabrics.

3 Sparkling under halogen light, Vitrine from Moserform's Sabina collection, \$7,920, is crafted of black walnut. The cabinet features scaled saber legs, a glass door, three wood-framed glass shelves and a mirrored back.

4 Hand-painted in red, the Chinese Bookcase from Chelsea House. \$1,338, features a trellis pattern. The wooden étagère measures 70 inches high and 31.5 inches wide.

5 Swarovski crystals encrusted onto the frame and mirror add extra sparkle to Galileo by Roger Thomas for Lewis Mittman, \$6,100. Finished in gold platinum leaf, the piece measures 50 inches in diameter but is also available in custom sizes.
